Any institution, preferably Philosophy Department of any college or university may apply for Lecture Grant.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The lecture programme may be organized on any relevant topic of Indian Philosophy, by an eminent scholar on the subject.
2. The shortlisted application will be considered for the release of one-time grant (Rs. 25,000/- for physical lecture and Rs. 10,000/- for lecture organized online).
3. The decision of the ICPR authority in the selection of the application will be final and can't be challenged.
4. The application lecture grant must include the following documents:
 - a) Filled up prescribed application format
 - b) A synopsis of the lecture from the speaker (Not more than 500 words)
 - c) Bank account detail of the college/ university
 - d) Niti Ayog Registration number, if the programme is to be organized by an NGO.
 - e) A tentative budget
5. The application must reach the ICPR before **August 10, 2021**. **Application received after the last date will not be accepted for consideration.**
