Terms and Conditions:

1. The research paper, including reference, etc. should be around 5000 words and typed one.
2. The paper must be an original work by the author and the paper or any part of it should not be a copy of any published work by any author or the author herself /himself and be free from plagiarism.
3. The decision of the ICPR authority regarding inclusion or rejection of the write up in the Commemorative Volumes will be final and no author can raise any objection on the decision of ICPR authority in this regard or seek reason/ explanation for rejection.
4. Un-published paper will not be returned to the author or any intimation regarding non- inclusion will be issued.
5. ICPR may make necessary editing, grammatical or factual changes or shorten the whole or a part of the write up without any intimation to the author.
6. The copyright of the published paper will be with ICPR and the author /any other institution cannot publish the paper or a part of it without prior written permission from ICPR authority.
7. The author has to certify that the write up is original one and it or part of it was not published in printed or electronic form.
