The eleventh-century classic, Nyāyavārttikatātparyapariśuddhi, forms the fourth tier of that quartet of commentaries, Nyāyacaturgranthikā, which has been regarded for more than nine hundred year as the central corpus of ancient Nyāya. Apart from analysing nearly every line of Vācaspati's Tātparyaṭikā, this vast yet tersely written gloss adds fresh philosophical insights engaging in debates with Buddhist stalwarts like Jñānśrīmitra and with philosophers like Śrīvatsa. This is the first critically edited complete publication of the works eagerly awaited by traditional as well as modern scholars of Nyāya in India and abroad.
