Terms and Conditions:

1. The Workshop will require full-time involvement of participants for a week (seven days)
2. Only Assistant Professors and Associate Professors of Philosophy and Allied Subjects of Universities/ Colleges can apply for participation.
3. Participation is restricted to candidates from the respective region.
4. A candidate can participate in only one of the above six Workshops.
5. Mere submission of application will not guarantee participation. Regarding selection of participants, ICPR's decision will be final and no one can challenge the same.
6. Participation for a selected candidate is subject to submission of NOC from the competent authority at least 15-days before the Workshop.
7. Besides lectures, round-table discussions may be organized every day, preferably in the afternoon, in which each of the participants may be given an opportunity to share her/ his views on the topic taught.
8. It is mandatory for all the participants to submit overall assessment-cum-feedback at the end of the workshop, before Valedictory. The successful participants will be issued 'Participation Certificate' signed by Coordinator and Member Secretary, ICPR.
9. Dates and venue may be changed conveniently for which proper intimation may be given to the selected candidates.
10. Outstation participants may be provided with boarding and lodging facilities on request. Travel expenses may be reimbursed to the participants as per ICPR norms. No DA for other allowances will be paid by ICPR.
