2. Assistant Professors and Associate Professors of Philosophy/ Social Sciences/ Humanities of Universities/ Colleges can apply for participation.
3. Participation is restricted to candidates from the respective region.
4. A candidate can participate in only one of the above four Workshops.
5. Mere submission of application will not guarantee participation. Regarding selection of participants, ICPR's decision will be final and no one can challenge the same.
6. Participation of a selected candidate is subject to submission of NoC from the competent authority of the college/ university where the applicant is working.
7. It is mandatory for all the participants to submit overall assessment-cum-feedback at the end of the workshop, before valedictory. The successful participants will be issued 'Participation Certificate'.
8. Dates and venue may be changed conveniently for which proper intimation may be given to the selected candidates.
9. Outstation participants may be provided with boarding and lodging facilities on request. Travel expenses may be reimbursed to the outstation participants as per ICPR norms. No DA or other allowances will be paid by ICPR.
